

ABSTRACT

The objective of the present study was to examine the direct and indirect impacts of childhood sexual abuse on maternal attitudes, perceptions, and behavior. The study's participants were a subset of 357 primiparous women interviewed at 28 to 32 weeks' gestation between the fall of 1990 and early 1992. At the time of the initial interview, almost 35% of the women reported sexual abuse before age 18. In 1995 and 1996, 265 women, 74% of the original sample, were re-interviewed when their children were between two and fours years old. In this sample 40% of the respondents had been identified as sexually abused in the first study. In the follow-up interview variables measuring parenting outcomes included: child-rearing competence, satisfaction, and efficacy; parenting stress; discipline practices; and family functioning. Variables measuring possible mediating factors between a history of sexual abuse and parenting practices included: education, occupation, income, family structure; current physical and mental health parameters, particularly depressive symptomatology; perceived current stresses unrelated to parenting; current family violence or sexual victimization; and parental sense of mastery. The data file distributed for this study contains 265 cases and 556 variables.

OVERVIEW

Background

There has been great interest in the research and clinical literature in the intergenerational impact of child maltreatment. Much of the literature has been concerned with "the cycle of violence," in which physical abuse in childhood is a component. In contrast, there is very little information available about how sexual abuse in childhood affects later parenting practices. There is a need, however, to increase our knowledge of the possible long-term consequences of sexual abuse. A better understanding of the pathways by which previous sexual abuse affects later functioning might lead to more effective assessments. More accurate risk assessment might decrease the risk of child maltreatment in the next generation (Caffo, et al., 1982; Altemeier, et al., 1979; Altemeier, et al., 1984).

The clinical and research literature suggests that sexual abuse during childhood can have both immediate and long-term developmental and behavioral consequences (Browne & Finkelhor, 1986; Beitchman, et al. 1992). Estimates of the nature, severity and prevalence of these effects vary according to individual and family background characteristics as well as the severity, duration, and type of abuse (Wyatt & Peters, 1986a, 1986b). Research methodology, population studied, and definitions of abuse also contribute to varying estimates of the long-term impact of sexual abuse. Evidence "conveys a clear suggestion that sexual abuse is a serious mental health problem, consistently associated with very disturbing subsequent problems" in some important proportion of its victims (Browne & Finkelhor, 1986, p.72). What is not known is whether there is a direct relationship between early sexual abuse and the development and implementation of parenting skills and behaviors, or whether the impact on parenting (if any) is mediated by a variety of background, situational, social support, and other intervening factors.

Purpose of the Project

The first objective of the present study was to explore the relationship between sexual abuse before age 18 and selected parenting skills, perceptions, and behaviors including parenting efficacy, parenting satisfaction and competence, parenting stress, and discipline practices. The second objective was to investigate the impact of different levels of severity of sexual abuse on later parenting behaviors.

To investigate the possible links between early sexual abuse and parenting outcomes, a group of women who had been interviewed before the birth of their first child were re-interviewed. The first study had explored the impact of sexual abuse in childhood on the adult women's functioning during their first pregnancy. Two hundred and sixty-five of the original 357 participants were re-interviewed when their infants were two to four years old in an attempt to quantify the impact of early sexual abuse on parenting behaviors. Specifically, the follow-up study examined whether a direct or indirect independent effect of sexual abuse in childhood is associated with an abused individual's parenting.

Definition of Sexual Abuse and Prevalence

Russell's (1983) questions were adapted to probe for a history of sexual abuse during the first interview. The women who had reported at least one contact or non-contact episode before the age of 18 were considered cases; those who did not were considered controls. The perpetrator could have been either family or non-family. Generally the perpetrator had to be five years older than the victim except in those cases in which the woman reported force was used. All such women were included in the abuse group. Women who reported situations that appeared to be consensual or adolescent experimentation, even if described as "unwanted," were placed in the comparison group. Women whose only experience occurred when they were 18 or older were also put in the comparison group even recognizing that there may have been sequelae to their experiences. Severity of abuse was categorized on the basis of the following: penetration or attempted penetration, contact but no attempted penetration, and non-contact.

The sexual abuse prevalence in the first sample was 35%; in the sample of 265 women who were interviewed a second time it was 40%.

Characteristics of the Participants in the Original Study

Three hundred and fifty-seven women participated in the original study. African American women comprised 71% of the sample. Seventy percent of the women had a high school degree; 25% of the women had a college degree or higher. One or more past sexual abuse incidents were reported by 35% of the sample. Approximately 30% of the reported abuse was intra-familial. Penetration was involved in 37% of the incidents and force or threats were described in 45% of the situations. There were no significant differences between women who reported sexual abuse and those who did not in ethnicity, education, or other demographic characteristics.

Women who reported sexual abuse, however, had significantly higher mean scores on a measure of depressive symptomatology. They also reported more life stresses and significantly more physical and verbal abuse both in childhood and the present than did women who reported no sexual abuse experiences. There were few differences in perceived social support during pregnancy between the groups (Benedict, Paine & Paine, 1994).

Characteristics of the Participants in the Second Study

Of the 357 participants in the original study, 20 were considered ineligible for a second interview. This ineligible group included six cases in which the mother or child had died, ten instances of the mother living outside the country and four others. Nineteen of the earlier participants (5.3%) refused to participate in the second round of interviews. Forty-nine of the original participants (13.7%) could not be located. Two of the original participants were located, agreed to participate and then could not be engaged in the interview. A total of 267 (74.9%) of the original participants were located and re-interviewed. Two of these interviews were discarded because of incompleteness or subsequently determined ineligibility, leaving a final sample of 265.

Respondents and non-respondents were compared. Significantly more of the women who reported past sexual abuse agreed to a second interview than non-abused women, but there did not appear to be any differences in the characteristics of the two groups' abuse episodes. Similar numbers reported the use of force, only one episode, and penetration. In addition, there were no significant differences in family structure, hospital payment source, education, employment, violence, or indicators of depression during pregnancy.

The demographic characteristics of the abused and non-abused women in the second sample were similar. The majority of the second sample was black (73%); 80.5% reported at least a high school education or GED. Almost 18% of the sample reported being in school or training programs at the time of the interview and 52.3% were working. Forty of the women had partners of whom 88% were working. Over 50% of the sample had never been married. Over 40% of the participants were very poor (an income of less than \$15,000 a year) while a third had household incomes of over \$30,000 annually.

Study Variables

Variables measuring parenting outcomes included:

Parenting competence, satisfaction, and efficacy

Parenting stress

Discipline practices

Family functioning

Variables that might be mediating factors between sexual abuse history and parenting included:

Education, occupation, income, family structure

Current physical and mental health, particularly depressive symptomatology

Perceived current stresses unrelated to parenting

Current family violence or sexual victimization

Parental sense of mastery

Instruments

Five instruments, the Parenting Stress Index, the Parenting Sense of Competence Scale, the Family APGAR, the Hassles Scale, and the Mastery Scale, were administered for the first time in the second round of interviews. Two instruments, the Center for Epidemiologic Studies Depression Scale and the Conflict Tactics Scale, were administered for a second time.

Parenting Stress Index

Parenting stress was assessed by the Parenting Stress Index (PSI) (Abidin, 1979, 1982). The PSI is a 101-item instrument that was developed to measure stress factors in parent-child interactions; to identify the risk of maltreatment or poor parenting; and to measure the parental perceptions of their child's adjustment.

The 101 items of the PSI are grouped into two domains (*Child Characteristics* and *Mother Characteristics*), which include 13 sub-scales.

The six sub-scales for the *Child Characteristics* domain are:

Child Adaptability or Plasticity

Acceptability of Child to Mother

Child Demandingness or Degree of Bother

Child Mood

Child Distractibility/Activity

Child Reinforcement of Mother

The seven sub-scales for the *Mother Characteristics* domain are:

Mother's Depression, Unhappiness, and Guilt

Mother's Sense of Competence

Mother's Attachment to Child

Restrictions Imposed by Parenting

Social Isolation

Relationship with Spouse or Significant Other

Parental Health

The PSI is predictive of both physical abuse and neglect, as well as "poor parenting" in general, is easy to administer, and has good psychometric properties. It is usually self-completed, requiring 20 to 30 minutes, but can be read to respondents.

Parenting Sense of Competence Scale (PSOC)

This instrument measures subjects' perceived parenting competence (Gibaud-Wallston & Wandersman, 1978). The PSOC has 17 items that measure two dimensions of the construct sense of competence: parenting satisfaction and parenting efficacy. Each item is answered on a 6-point scale, ranging from strongly agree (1) to strongly disagree (6). The total score is computed by summing the item scores. Higher scores indicate greater perceived competence.

Family APGAR

This measure is a 5-item, 3-choice scale that examines five areas of family functioning. Items are scored from *almost always* (1) to *hardly ever* (3). APGAR is an acronym for adaptability, partnership, growth, affection, and resolve (Smilkstein, 1978). In comparisons of non-clinical and clinical families, significant differences were found on scores in these areas. This scale has been successfully used as a screening tool by practitioners interested in family functioning. A lower score indicates higher family functioning.

Hassles Scale

This scale consists of 11 items designed to evaluate the worry or stress associated with events of daily living. Responses fall on a 4-point scale ranging from *very much* (1) to *not at all* (4). Lower total scores indicate less adaptive resources in dealing with daily stress.

Mastery Scale

This instrument measures mastery, perceived as one dimension of self-concept. The scale contains 9 items that measure the extent to which an individual feels his or her life chances

are under personal control. It was chosen to measure the mothers' feelings of mastery or of mastery's opposite, powerlessness, in their parental role. Responses range from *strongly disagree* (1) to *strongly agree* (4). A lower score is indicative of a greater sense of mastery.

Center for Epidemiologic Studies Depression Scale (CES-D)

This 20-item scale measures depressive symptomatology in the general population. Respondents are asked about the frequency of various feelings and behaviors over the past week. Responses range from *rarely or none of the time (less than 1 day a week*, value = 1) to *most or all of the time (5-7 days a week*, value = 4). Higher scores indicate more depressive symptoms. The scale has been shown to be valid and reliable over time and has been used with a variety of populations (Ensel, 1986).

Conflict Tactics Scale

The Conflict Tactics Scale violence sub-scale (CTS-V) measures current physical and verbal violence perpetrated against and by the study subject (Straus, 1979; Straus & Gelles, 1989). The frequency of 15 possible reactions to family differences is assessed by the questions. The CTS-V is a widely accepted instrument designed to measure the frequency of violent acts in response to family conflict, as perpetrated by one family member against another.

Additional Measures

Several individual questions were asked to measure respondents' attitudes toward discipline, particularly attitudes about spanking, other corporal discipline, or verbal discipline.

Respondents were asked about their partner's or the baby's father's involvement in caring for and disciplining the child.

Smoking, drinking, and drug use were assessed.

Data Collection

The information used to locate participants and to classify them as abused or non-abused was gathered from prior medical records. All potential study participants received a letter describing the study. The letter introduced the investigators, described how names were obtained, and explained that participation involved a 75-90 minute interview for which participants would be paid \$25.00. The letter also described how confidentiality would be maintained and that participation was completely voluntary. When possible, a follow-up telephone call was made to request an interview time.

At the time of the interview, the study was again explained, questions answered, and informed consent obtained. Although most of the interviews were done in person, 19.1% were done by telephone. This group of interviewees lived outside of the study area.

Data Quality Procedures

The investigators instituted several procedures to ensure the quality of the interview data. The interviewers were trained, and a pretest was used to uncover and correct any areas of potential confusion for the interviewers.

All questionnaires were checked for completeness and accuracy. Any incomplete forms were discussed with the interviewers.

Once the data were entered on the computer, blank spaces, missing values, and inappropriate codes were deleted or corrected. In the final data cleaning step the investigators inspected the frequency distributions for appropriate categories. In addition, the consistency of dates and related items was checked both within and between questionnaires. If inconsistencies were found in either dates or objective measures, the current interview data were used. The data from the second questionnaire was then linked with the data from the previous study to define the study groups.

Results

Overall, there were few results indicating any significant direct effects of sexual abuse in childhood on the parenting outcomes measured. Severity of abuse did not have direct effects on the measures, although women who had reported the most severe abuse tended report a greater degree of parental stress. Comparisons of the abused and non-abused groups on individual measures suggested that previously abused women had decreased family functioning, lower efficacy in the parenting role, higher levels of depressive symptoms, and more hassles in the prior year. Childhood sexual abuse was not, however, a significant predictor in multivariate analyses that included physical abuse in childhood, age, SES, current depression, life hassles, and current violence. Current life hassles and SES explained the efficacy scores; hassles, SES, and depressive symptoms were most important in explaining family functioning.

NOTE TO USERS: While Benedict's final report describes the use of a severity of abuse variable in her original analyses, the severity variable is not included in the dataset that NDACAN distributes.

DESCRIPTION OF THE DATA FILE

This data collection consists of a User's Guide and Codebook, an Interview Instrument, a Final Report, a Read Me file, and the Data.

File Characteristics

NDACAN distributes one data file for this study. A brief description of the file is provided below. Frequencies and summary statistics are available from the NDACAN Web site.

The data used in this study are contained in the file "DS_085v1a". The file contains 556 variables and 265 cases.

The variable ANYSA2 identifies abused and non-abused respondents. There is no severity of abuse or ethnicity variable, however.

The variables in "DS_085v1a" are arranged by content domain. The table below indicates how the leading characters in the variable's name map onto the related domain.
