1. Four versions of the survey were given to four different populations that work in child welfare:
 - a. Child welfare professionals working with state, county, or private agencies
 - b. Child welfare professionals working with tribes
 - c. Legal professionals
 - d. Social work students

Each survey had differences in questions shown; these differences are described in the relevant entries in this codebook.

2. For each variable, the codebook includes a reference number listing the location for that item in a particular survey under “Item Location”. The surveys are referenced as follows:
 - a. S: Child welfare professionals working with state, county, or private agencies
 - b. T: Child welfare professionals working with tribes
 - c. C: Legal professionals
 - d. U: Social work students

Each reference number includes a single letter and a two-digit number representing the item number in the survey, as follows:
