

• 905,000 maltreated children


#### NIS-4






**Categories of Children**



NIS-4 includes variables on: countability, sources, home and family, child, perpetrator, population, weights, and maltreatment; and items from the CPS Screening Policies and Sentinel Definition Survey Supplemental Studies.

NIS datasets 1 - 3 are also available from NDACAN.

### **Conducting NIS-4 Analyses**

- READ\_ME\_FIRST.pdf
- PUF Manual (User's Guide) and Codebook
- PUF: 1,844 variables on 12,694 cases of ONLY the maltreated children
- You MUST use the weights (JK2)
- Use WesVar, SUDAAN, SAS, R, or Stata (.svr package)
- Calculate known estimates
- Sample syntax is available on the NDACAN website
- NIS-4 does not include substantiation variables
